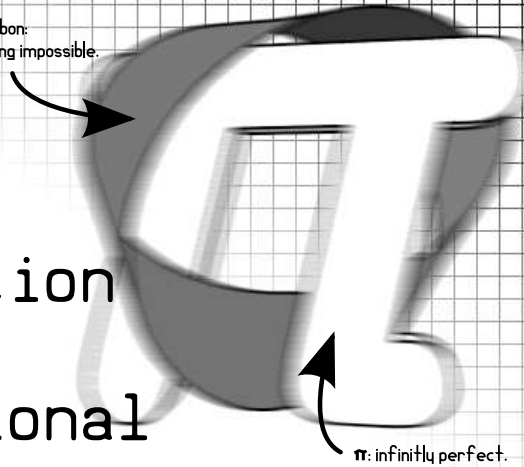

Imagine yourself as a user in following situation:

The Operating System the majority uses is slow, inefficient and error-prone.
All alternatives available have as many disadvantages and pitfalls.
None of them combines all strengths into one.

What would you rather do:

- Stick with the system I am used to, even if that implies the risk of losing everything.
- Pick one of the alternatives and cope with its restraints and shortcomings.
- Write a new one from scratch in collaboration with others

Actually, we had this situation before. But this time, it's not "just" about personal computers. This time, it's real. This time, it's about the world we actually live in (RL™).

Does the current political system seem somewhere between suboptimal and broken beyond repair to you?

Then what about taking a blank sheet to draft a new world governance system designed to distribute resources efficiently, minimize risks and solve issues?

5 easy steps to World revolution:

1. collate ideas and proposals for constructing an optimized form of society
2. work out in detail general concepts and dynamic organisational structures of new world order, fully utilizing 21st century technology where rational
3. compile a coherent alternative world governance plan, implement its algorithms
4. campaign the media and convince more than half of mankind (by explaining the personal benefits to everyone)
5. democratically establish it! (global referendum ~2014?)

loose summary of fundamental core precepts:

- reset society's mind set (based on mutual agreement that we all want to enjoy living in peace and that any human being's net value by definition is exactly one human being):
 - reason (efficiency + maximise fellic calculus + respect for human rights) as defining skill of mankind should be embraced on all levels as much as possible
 - state as community of citizens run by citizens
 - promote positive human values (creativity, courage, tolerance, empathy..)
 - fight the dark side (greed, hatred, laziness, intolerance, ignorance..)
 - perfection is not possible, but must be targeted to even come close
 - fault tolerance is vital (stuff happens, mistakes are made to learn.)
- refine democracy to enable everyone to contribute ideas and voice opinion:
 - gather all valid arguments and bring relevant experts together (-> discussion threads with write-restricted and free-for-all branch, poll affected people..)
 - reasoning based consent instead of political compromises (politics)
 - teams qualified for the task voluntarily taking liability instead of single politicians/parties receiving power by majority decision every 4 years
 - automate bureaucracy: let software do algorithmic tasks (human error)
 - heavily protect and restrict access to personal data (Big Brother problem)
 - avoid single points of failure:
 - spread responsibilities (self moderating teams)
 - spread the data (decentralized data storage: hash, backup & parity)
 - preserve traditional crafts and offline means of communication etc. to maintain independence from electricity and high-technology
 - always prepare "PLAN B" for case of G-AU/ worst case scenario
 - disestablish concept of "intellectual property" from reality - culture is remixing! no patents, no copyright: share all information. FREE THE BITZ.
 - transform the internet into the XMLed sea of data we all want: make every bit of data in media archives, libraries and anywhere else accessible
